**Local Restaurant to Let Cape Fear Community College Take Over Their Kitchen**

*Bluewater to host benefit for local hospitality students*

Wrightsville Beach, NC – Bluewater is challenging hospitality management students at Cape Fear Community College (CFCC) to coordinate a full scale sit down fundraising event on location that will include a three course meal, live entertainment and a silent auction. The reward for their efforts? A generous donation towards educational scholarships to help with travel costs to an annual food show.

Bluewater's inaugural Foodraiser will benefit both the CFCC Pineapple Guild and the NC Hospitality Educational Fund (NC HEF).
